

A Letter From Deacon John

1st Sunday of Advent

The Deacon's Speakin'

Dear sisters and brothers,

"Be vigilant!" "Do not become drowsy!" "Don't be caught unaware!" Jesus warns His disciples in this Sunday's gospel. We begin another Advent season of waiting and watching. For some, it's a time of delight, waiting eagerly for Christmas, for anticipated gifts, for time off from work and school, and for happy gatherings with family and friends. For others, it's a dreaded time, as they approach their first holiday without a loved one or worry about how they will pay for the gifts and meals they want to provide. Whatever our situation, the Scripture reading today helps us to adopt a stance of faithful watching and waiting.

Most of us find waiting very difficult. We try to eliminate it as much as possible with distractions until the expected event arrives. The time of waiting and watching is not idle biding of time or maintaining the status quo. Like parents anticipating the birth of a child, we have much to do during the expectant months. In today's gospel, Jesus talks about not going after frivolous things that are short-lived and cause anxiety. Be watchful, He says, so as not to be taken by surprise. Pray for strength and don't be afraid. Stand tall and be ready for the embrace of the One who is Love made flesh.

The expectation of the birth of a child can often reignite the intensity of a love relationship. So too in Advent, if our hearts are weary or drowsy, our preparation for the celebration of the Christ child can spark our love again, not only toward the One who came to us as a child, but also to <u>all</u> of God's children.
