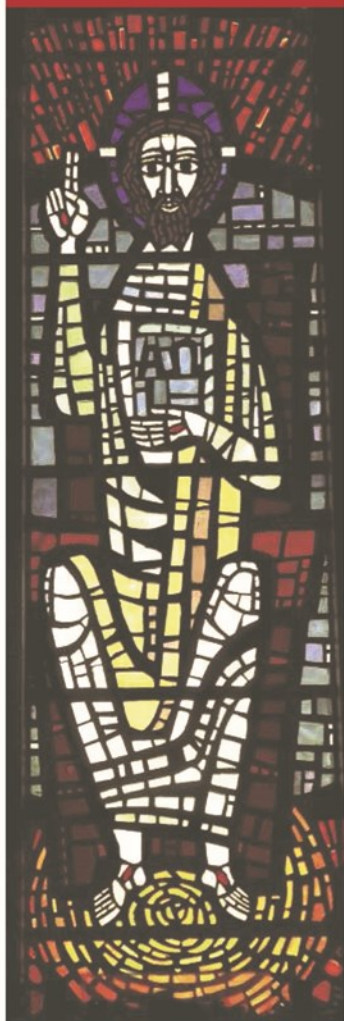

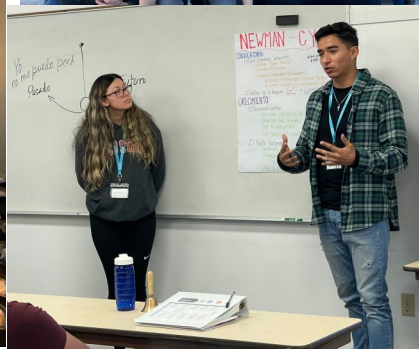

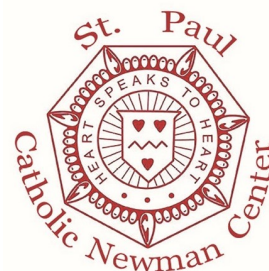
UNA IGLESIA EN MARCHA: EMERGING LEADERS FOR THE CHURCH

From February 25 to March 2, several of our Claretian Youth/Campus Ministry/Young Adult leaders (Lupita Franco, Mateo Nunez, Hector Rodriguez, Espie Garza, and Newman staff Karl Gurney) took an intensive course on Hispanic ministry at the Southeast Pastoral Institute (SEPI), in Miami, Florida. The week was filled with prayer, service, dialogue with diocesan workers and volunteers from across the country, and rich intercultural exchange (the course was entirely in Spanish!) 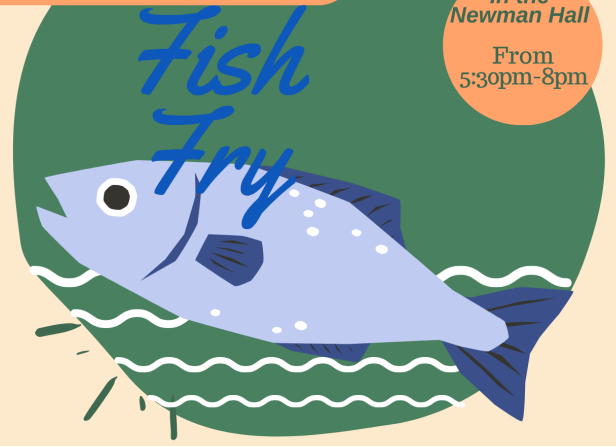

FATHER NEGRO SCHOLARSHIP **APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE!**

Applications for Sergio P Negro Scholarships for the 2024-25 academic year are now available on the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center web site. The Sergio P Negro Endowment Fund was established in honor of our founding priest, Sergio Negro, who had a deep and abiding commitment to education. The Endowment Fund anticipates awarding a minimum of two, \$2,500 scholarships to deserving students for the academic year. Past awardees are eligible to reapply as long as they have maintained satisfactory progress.

To be eligible, you must be either an upper division undergraduate or a graduate student preparing to use your knowledge and skills to witness and minister to others. This is meant to be inclusive of many vocations and forms of service, including education, medicine, social services, etc. A precondition is that you must have either been raised within or are currently affiliated and active with our St. Paul Catholic Newman Center parish beyond attending mass. An overall GPA of 2.5 or greater is also required.

The deadline for applications to be received is 5:00 pm on Sunday, April 21, 2024. They may be submitted electronically to Scholarship@csufnewman.com or mailed to Negro Scholarship, c/o St. Paul Catholic Newman Center, 1752 E. Barstow Ave., Fresno, CA 93710. In all cases, applications and accompanying documents must be typed. Final selection of awardees will be through an interview process.

Campesino Program: Rosaries for Outreach

The California State Council of the Knights of Columbus recently established a Campesino (farmworker) Program to support and assist those whose hard work brings food to our tables. Through the generosity of KofC councils around the State, and our local KofC Chapter and Councils, the Knights have coordinated with Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Fresno (CCDF) and funded a food distribution for campesino families. Over 5,000 permanent and seasonal farmworker jobs with the Prima Wawona Company will soon be eliminated by that company's recent closure.

The Knights, with CCDF logistical support, will be distributing 300 food boxes in Cutler during April. To show our support, and prayerful thanks and encouragement, we would like to include a Rosary in each food box. If you have a Rosary at home that you can spare, please enclose it in an envelope or small container and bring it to the Newman Center, noting "Campesino Program" on the envelope. Thank you for your help and support for our local Campesino families.
