

## Restarting Our Pastoral Council

A long process of listening, researching, discerning, and preparing are coming to an end with one last important piece. That piece involves all of our parish!

To make sure the working group has all in place, we have delayed this weekend's pastoral council educational sessions, so our schedule looks like this:

- ◆ Starting this week, look for educational information in the foyer and on the website. We want you to know about the different Pastoral Council Models and what other parishes use.
- ◆ After Masses on Apr 13/14, come to Cardinal Newman Hall after Mass to see a short presentation on pastoral councils and to ask questions about what you have heard or still want to know.
- ◆ After the presentations, you are invited to participate in Small Group discussions to listen to and share ideas with fellow parishioners.
- ◆ The weekends of Apr 20/21 and Apr 27/28, the parish will be invited to give their inputs on which pastoral model best fits our parish, and which goals are most important for our pastoral council to address.

We have received a lot of feedback in listening sessions that stated, "We need a Pastoral Council again". Now is your chance to be involved and make our Pastoral Council into a team of parishioners that will:

- 1) Gather parishioner ideas and needs to best support their faith journeys
- 2) Put energy into turning ideas into plans and programs to support the parish
- 3) Support parish staff to move the parish forward to meet the parish mission

We can only make this possible with your sharing and collaboration with your parish members. Your ideas and your voice are very important to truly make this a pastoral council that serves the whole parish.





### **APPLICATIONS NOW AVAILABLE!**

Applications for Sergio P Negro Scholarships for the 2024-25 academic year are now available on the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center web site. The Sergio P Negro Endowment Fund was established in honor of our founding priest, Sergio Negro, who had a deep and abiding commitment to education. The Endowment Fund anticipates awarding a minimum of two, \$2,500 scholarships to deserving students for the academic year. Past awardees are eligible to reapply as long as they have maintained satisfactory progress.

To be eligible, you must be either an upper division undergraduate or a graduate student preparing to use your knowledge and skills to witness and minister to others. This is meant to be inclusive of many vocations and forms of service, including education, medicine, social services, etc. A precondition is that you must have either been raised within or are currently affiliated and active with our St. Paul Catholic Newman Center parish beyond attending mass. An overall GPA of 2.5 or greater is also required.

The deadline for applications to be received is 5:00 pm on Sunday, April 21, 2024. They may be submitted electronically to [Scholarship@csufnewman.com](mailto:Scholarship@csufnewman.com) or mailed to Negro Scholarship, c/o St. Paul Catholic Newman Center, 1752 E. Barstow Ave., Fresno, CA 93710. In all cases, applications and accompanying documents must be typed. Final selection of awardees will be through an interview process.
