Greetings from Mexico!

I just wanted to take a few minutes to wish you a blessed Easter! You have been on my mind and prayers every day; and you all are my daily Mass intention.

I celebrated Holy Week in a small indigenous community in San Luis Potosi, Mexico, with the Tenek people. They don't speak Spanish; I had to learn a few

words to get by. Yet, there is one language that speaks clearer and louder than any other language: the language of God, translated into the Easter event:

In the Easter Gospel we see one of the first and immediate effects of the resurrection of Jesus: removing the stone. Today we see what's at the heart of Holy Week: and that is you! You are the reason why we celebrated the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. God knows that we can't help heavy stones that come upon us disguised as pain, illness, hurt, sin. Yet, there is no stone the resurrection of Jesus cannot remove. This is His promise to you: that God finds you worth his only and very Son's life, death and resurrection so that no stone can remain unmoved in your life.

Happy Easter parish family! I do love you and I can't wait to see you in June!
