





Sergio P. Negro Scholar Applications Now Available

The Sergio P Negro Endowment was established in honor of our founding priest of the Newman Center, who had a deep and abiding commitment to education. We anticipate awarding a minimum of two \$2500 scholarships to deserving students.

To be eligible, you must be either an upper division undergraduate or a graduate student preparing to use your knowledge and skills to witness and minister to others. This is meant to be inclusive of many vocations and forms of service, including education, medicine, social services, etc. A pre-condition is that you must have either been raised within or are currently affiliated and active with our St. Paul Catholic Newman Center parish beyond attending Mass.

An overall GPA of 2.5 or greater is also required.
