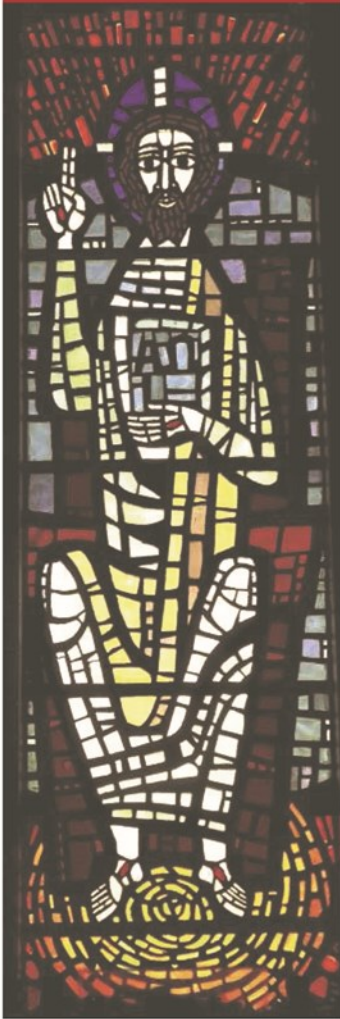

It will be a prayerful and uplifting day--and fun too!

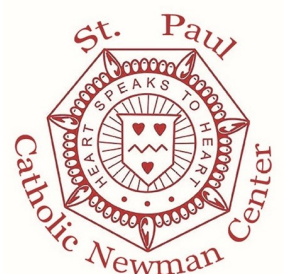
I'm looking forward to it, and we all look forward to seeing YOU there too!
