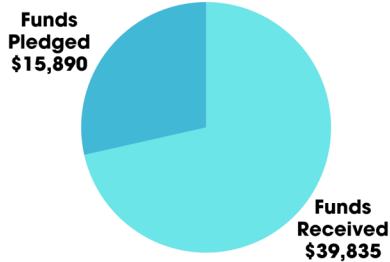




RECTORY RENOVATIONS
