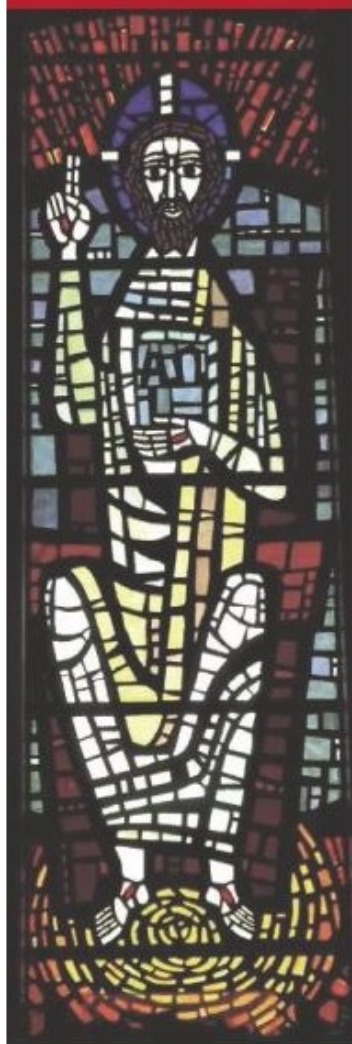

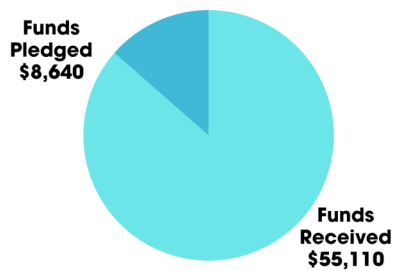
RECTORY RENOVATIONS
