#### **Community Garden Ministry Update**

#### July 15, 2024

The St. Paul Catholic Newman Center Community Garden Ministry will significantly transform access to fresh, healthy produce to needy residents of the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center community. Our mission is to bring the transformative power of Christ to the needy of our community through WORD AND ACTION by supporting shared growing of fruits and vegetables in community garden plots.

An important component of this ministry is to provide support to our gardeners and to monitor the operation of our community garden. We are looking for parishioners to volunteer 4-6 hours a month for 6-8 months a year to help us make this a highly successful ministry.

Our Community Garden Ministry is located on a half-acre west of our Cardinal Newman Hall. The garden will consist of:

- Enclosed by a decorative wooden fence and gate.
- A 10-foot gate with a 20-foot by 40-foot concrete entrance,
- A 10-foot by 12-foot storage shed and a 8-foot X 16-foot composting bin,
- 35 garden beds 20-foot by 4-foot expanding to 70 beds in 18 months, security lighting, and decorative trees and brushes surrounding the wooden fence.

The 35 community garden plots will be allocated:

• 25 plots for low-income residents, and 10 plots for St. Paul Catholic Newman Center parishioners.
