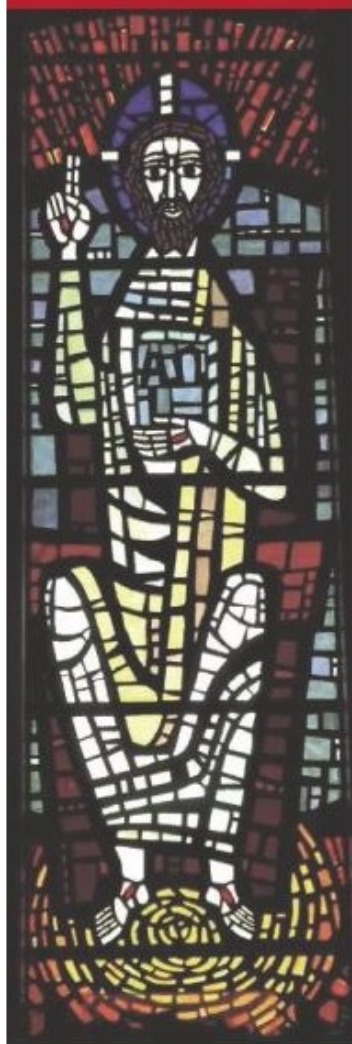

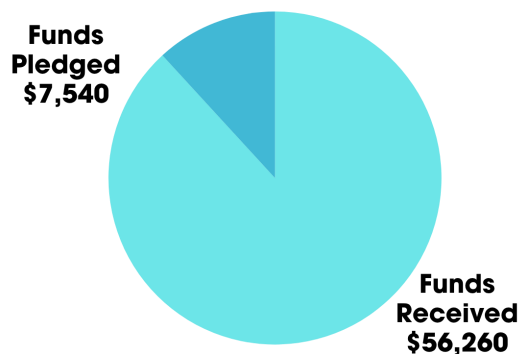
## RECTORY RENOVATIONS
