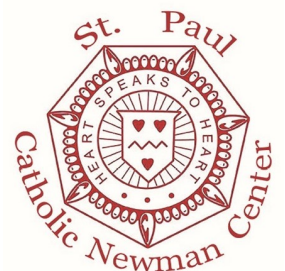

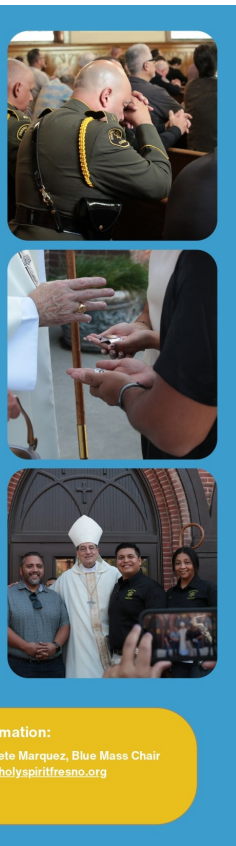

OBJECTIVES OF OUR MINISTRY

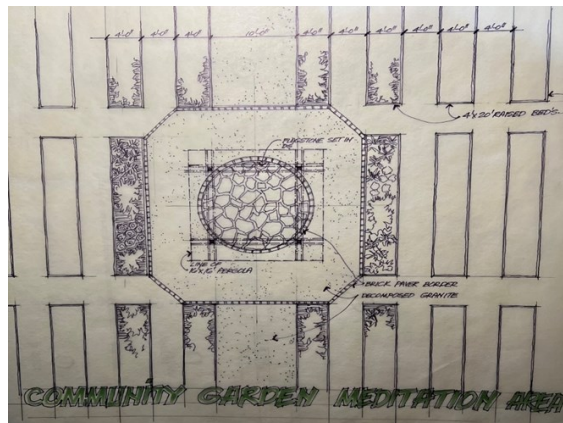
- 72 raised garden beds for low-income families.
