

### Founders Day Recalls Father Negro's Legacy

As we prepare for Founders Day the weekend of Sept. 7-8, we reflect on our St. Paul Catholic

Newman Center founding pastor, Fr. Sergio P. Negro. One reason our church is alive with vibrant and varied artwork and music is Father Negro's passion for the fine arts. What you may not know is that he and Monsignor James Peterson played Baroque music on recorders (low-tech flutes) with harpsichord and other accompaniment. We hear the accompaniment was fine, the recorders less so, but we're grateful for the artful legacy of Father Negro.

In the 1950s, Fresno State Catholic students gathered with Fr. Negro at the Shrine of St. Therese. However, as Fresno State transitioned from what is now the Fresno City College campus to its current location at Cedar and Shaw campus, this became inconvenient. Classes were held on both campuses for a time. Father Negro spearheaded creation of a Newman Center near the new campus, celebrating our parish's first Mass in our "new" chapel in 1964.

The mission of our Friday Dinner Ministry is to continue outreach to the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center community by enriching the lives of those most in need of assistance.

This ministry averages 8 volunteers per week organized around a weekly team lead that serves as lead cook, parishioners willing to volunteer 1 Friday per month, along with a large pool of alternative parishioner volunteers. The estimated number of volunteer hours dedicated to this ministry from July 2023-June 2024 totaled 1,372.

Our wonderful Friday Dinner Ministry served 2,011 meals from July 2023-June 2024, which reflected an increase of 30% over prior year. With much of the food used to prepare meals coming from donated sources such as the Vineyard Farmers Market, 9,500 pounds of food was recovered, thus minimizing discard while providing access to high quality, nutritious meals.

Thank you to all those that volunteer tirelessly serving the community in the Friday Dinner Ministry!
