

The Epiphany Chalk Blessing

On the weekend of January 4-5, we will bless chalk for families to take in celebration of the Epiphany on January 6.

The Epiphany chalk tradition, associated with the Three Magi (or Wise Men), is a simple way to ask God's blessing upon your home for the coming year. Using the blessed chalk, mark your doorway with 20 + C + M + B + 26, while reciting a short prayer.

The letters C + M + B represent the traditional names of the Magi —Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar—as well as the Latin phrase Christus Mansionem Benedicat, meaning "May Christ bless this house." The crosses symbolize Christ's presence and blessing.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES TRUCK


The Catholic Charities Truck parks in our East Parking Lot to collect donations on the first weekend of the month.


