DEDICATION OF THE St. PAUL CATHOLIC NEWMAN CENTER COMMUNITY GARDEN AND MEDITATION AREA MINISTRY

Fr. Byron and Fr. Paul are returning to join Fr. Rubi and Fr. Bill for the dedication of the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center Community Garden and Meditation Area Ministry.

The dedication will take place at the Community Garden on Sunday, October 13th at 6:45 pm as part of the 7:00 Mass. The Community Garden and Meditation Area is located behind Cardinal Newman Hall.

The Meditation Area is a dream of Fr. Byron to serve as a place for our gardeners and parishioners to contemplate the love Christ has for everyone and for us to contemplate how we can fulfill Christ's message:

"For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me". (Matthew 25:35).

The intent of the Community Garden is to provide 70 raised, irrigated beds that are 20 feet long by 4 feet wide and 1 foot high for low-income community families including our parishioners to supplement their diets with vegetables they would not otherwise purchase.

The Community Garden will also include 20 fruit trees with some of the fruit sold at local farmers' markets to help make the Community Garden self-sufficient with the remainder of the fruit given to needy families throughout the community.

Fr. Rubi noted that "the Community Garden will impact over 350 low-income residents of our community to enrich their lives by growing their own fruits and vegetables and sharing them with their extended families. It will encourage their children to see the value of working in the soil and intrinsic rewards of planting and growing vegetables. It will also instill the positive values of working together to accomplish rewarding results and addressing the concerns of Pope Francis to seek a sustainable environment."

The Community Garden is a partnership effort that includes the Newman Center, Fresno State students, Stone Soup Fresno, the Master Gardeners of Fresno County, and Fresno Metro Ministry.

Please join us on Sunday, October 13th at 6:45 pm as we dedicate the Community Garden .

Please note that the blessing and opening prayer for the 7:00pm Mass on this date will begin in the Community Garden, followed by a community procession into the Chapel.


