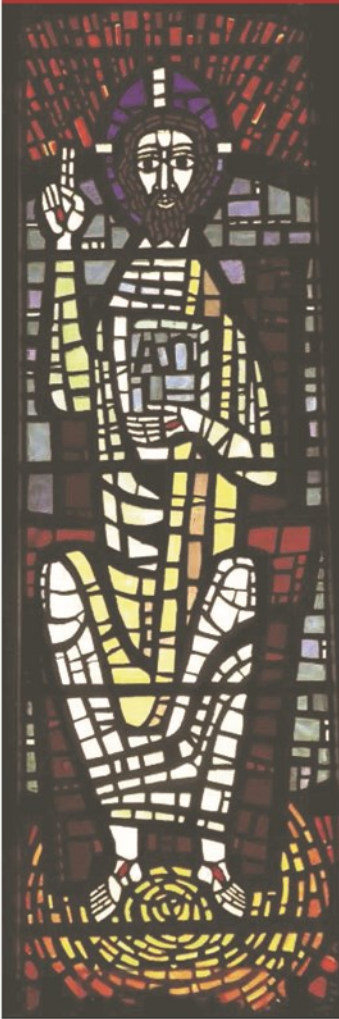

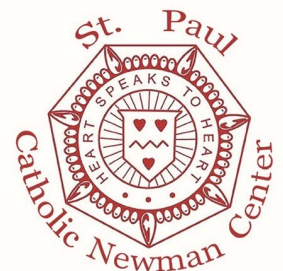

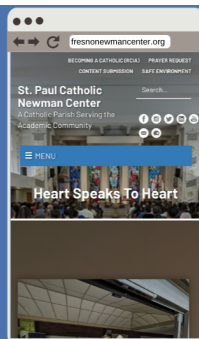
RCIA Program

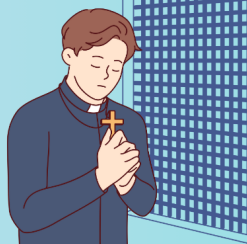
