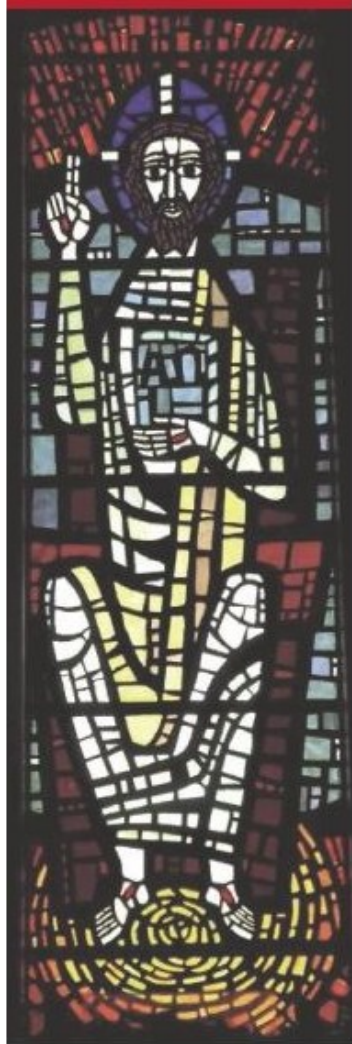

### WEDNESDAY COLLEGE NIGHT

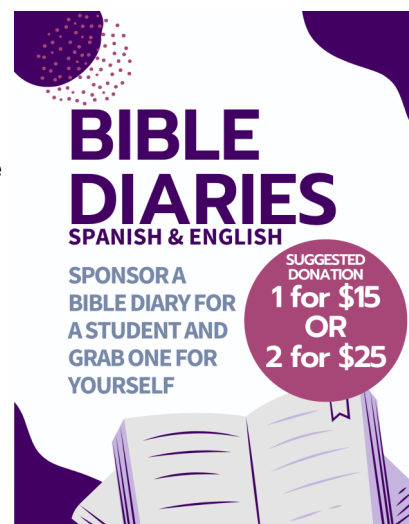
