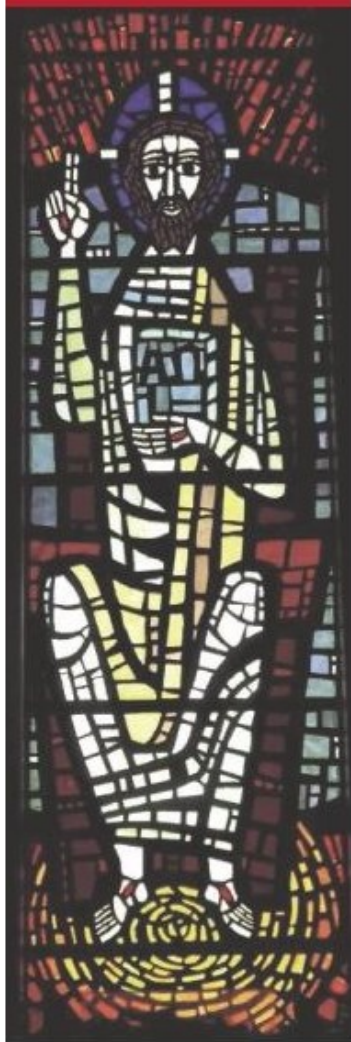

MARRIAGE ENRICHMENT - PRAYING AS A COUPLE

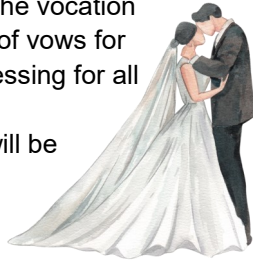
