



Saturday 3/7/26 we will carpool to Three Rivers, CA and
hike the Case Mountain Reserve (BLM). The hike is
considered easy, but there are a few very short steeper
inclines. The trail is a dirt path that is mostly flat and
follows a gradual descent. The trail takes you through
fields of wildflowers, oak trees, a pond and a stream. We
will have beautiful views of the Sierra mountains the
entire hike. We will pray our rosary on our hike and
meditate on our Lenten journey. Father Rubi is planning
