



## LAETARE SUNDAY: COMMUNAL ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Fourth Sunday in Lent is observed on March 14/15, 2026. This day is traditionally known as Laetare Sunday. Laetare means "Rejoice!"

Laetare Sunday provides us with encouragement as we progress toward the end of Lent. It is a small break from the penitential season that reminds us of the joy and hope ahead at Easter.

The theme of the day expresses the joy of this anticipation; and receiving the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is a wonderful way to strengthen our bodies, hearts and souls! We will celebrate a

communal Anointing of the Sick AFTER all the Masses on Laetare Saturday and Sunday: March 14/15.




