JOURNEY OF HOPE - FROM THE LITURGY COMMITTEE

One of my favorite lines in the musical, "Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat" happens in the midst of Joseph's pain while in prison, where it seems all hope is lost. But the chorus sings, "We've read the book and you come out on top." We can proclaim likewise; we have read the complete account of Jesus' life, death, and **resurrection**. We KNOW what happens, what we will celebrate in just one week. New life, new creation, Resurrection.

Let us celebrate this feast of Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, this roller coaster of a day that leads us to Resurrection. We also keep in prayer our Elect, who are days away from full initiation into the Church!

Where can you find hope for your own life this week? What hopes do you bring with you to the Baptismal waters at Easter?


HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION
