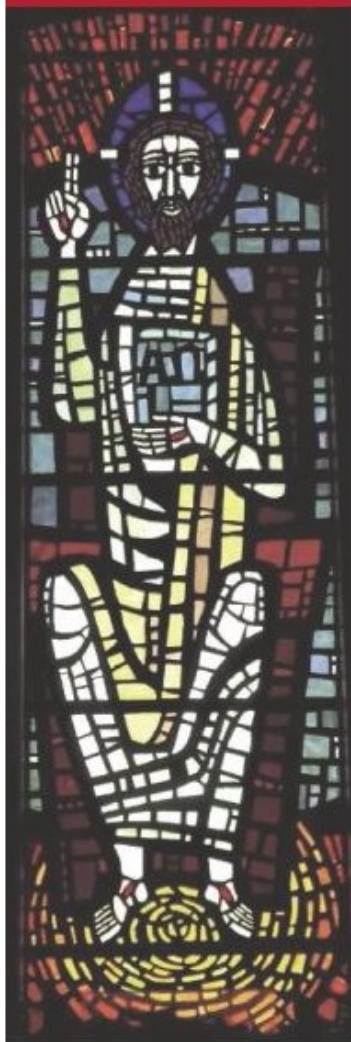

## Second Sunday of Easter April 27, 2025

### THANK YOU, FRANCISCUS

(This is the name that will be inscribed on his tomb)

On March 13, 2013, Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio was elected Pope. I wasn't particularly interested in the predictions about who the next pope might be—then or now. But when he first appeared as pontiff on the balcony of Saint Peter's Basilica, referring to himself simply as the "Bishop of Rome" and asking the people to pray for him, it was a breath of fresh air. That simple and humble gesture moved me deeply.

Pope Francis has had a huge influence on me as a priest. He has been the Pope from the very beginning of my priestly life. I was ordained in the Jubilee Year of Mercy in 2016, and I chose the Year of Mercy prayer for my ordination bookmark. His vision of a merciful and compassionate Church resonated deeply with the kind of priest I aspire to be.

Pope Francis is also the only pope I have ever seen face to face—not just once, but three times. I saw him in Washington, D.C. in 2015, in Quebec, Canada in 2022, and in Lisbon, Portugal in 2023. Each of those encounters holds a special place in my heart.

One moment in particular gave me chills. During World Youth Day in Lisbon, in one of his homilies, Pope Francis said, "There is room for everyone in the Church." He asked all of us to repeat the word "todos"—"everyone." In that moment, I felt the heart of the Church. A heart that is big enough to include all and is always enlarging to include even more.

On April 21, 2025, I woke up to the news that Pope Francis had died. Tears filled my eyes. But what brought me consolation was this: until the very end, he remained Pope Francis. When he returned from the hospital after a month, he didn't stay hidden behind the Vatican walls. He continued meeting people, praying for them, and praying with them. He died ministering to his flock. He died as he lived—as our shepherd.

He began his papacy asking the people to pray for him. Throughout his pontificate, he never stopped asking for those prayers.

Let us gather on **May 2nd at 6:00 PM** for the Rosary and Mass, praying for Pope Francis, entrusting him to the mercy of God.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.




