

# JOURNEY OF HOPE - FROM THE LITURGY COMMITTEE

This weekend we have some amazing signs of hope! Our scriptures of both Year C (which will be at most Masses) and Year A (the mass with the final Scrutiny for our Elect) are reflective of the resurrection to come!

First, the Year C Gospel, the woman caught in adultery, is a wonderful story of redemption. This woman, who thought she was to be condemned and her life would be over, instead has an encounter with Christ, who returns the judgement that was being shown to her right back to those who are judging her! He asks who among THEM is without sin, and of course, they walk away, giving this woman a new hope for her future.

Then, of course, Year A, which is reflected upon by our Elect as they prepare for Easter Vigil, is the raising of Lazarus. Mary and Martha, his sisters, are distressed that Jesus was not there to heal Lazarus, and poor Lazarus is in the tomb already. But Jesus, the Way, the Truth, and the Life, brings Lazarus out of the darkness and back to life!

As we near Holy Week, this is the time to reflect on both these Gospels and ponder this question: when I have felt hopeless, in darkness, how has the Lord shown me His presence? How can I prepare for the final days before Holy Week, ready for the Resurrection?

## STATIONS OF THE CROSS



## LET US DREAM LISTENING SESSIONS (HOUSE MEETINGS)


