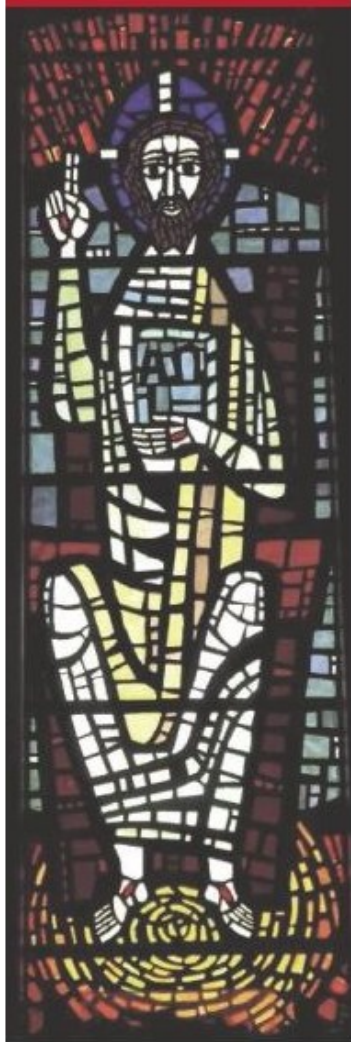

## UNITED SAN JOAQUIN, UNIDOS SAN JOAQUIN READY FOR ACTION

Last Sunday, over 80 Newman Members joined Bishop Brennan, two other Bishops, elected officials, community leaders, and over 700 energized Community Members at the UNITED San Joaquin Founding Convention! The excitement centered around 17 congregations, unions, and community organizations launching USJ.

The very diverse crowd was moved by stories from students, mothers, immigrants, and senior citizens on struggles with: housing, tuition and housing costs; mental health access; education cuts; immigration; and transportation.

They were encouraged by faith leaders’ words of hope and local leader commitments. USJ has opened a pathway to change with the power, energy, and will to make our community better.

USJ will host an information session for new people on May 14th, and a Delegate’s Assembly on June 1st to launch Action Teams.
