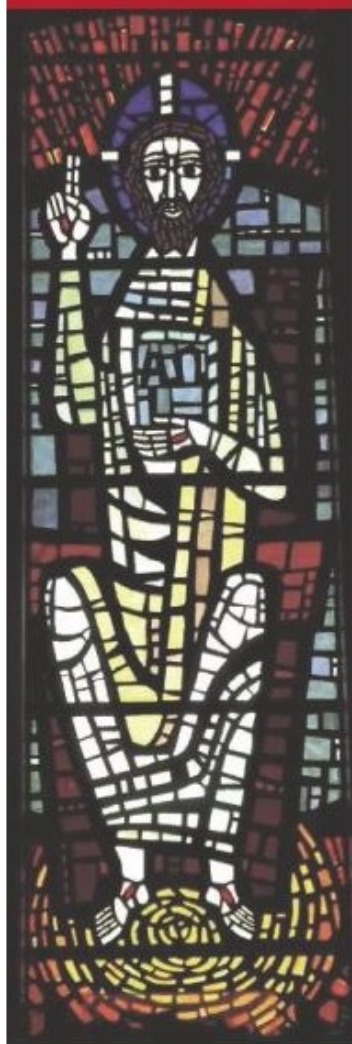

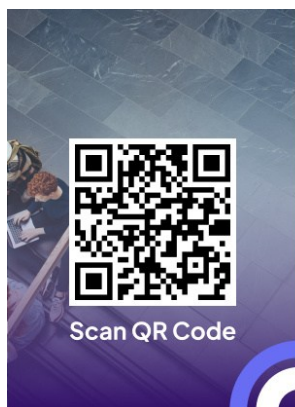

Young Adult Bible Study

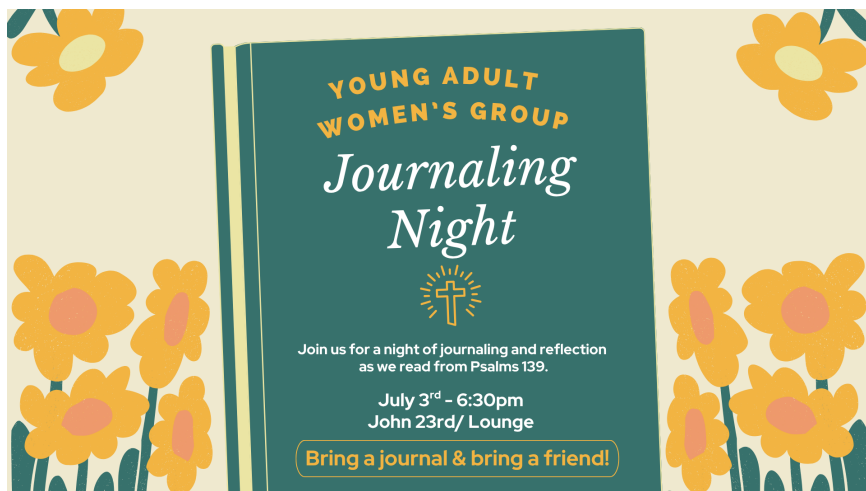

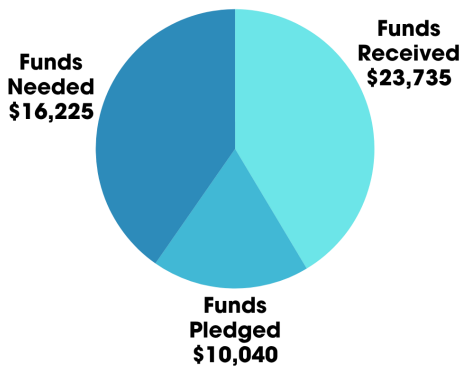
