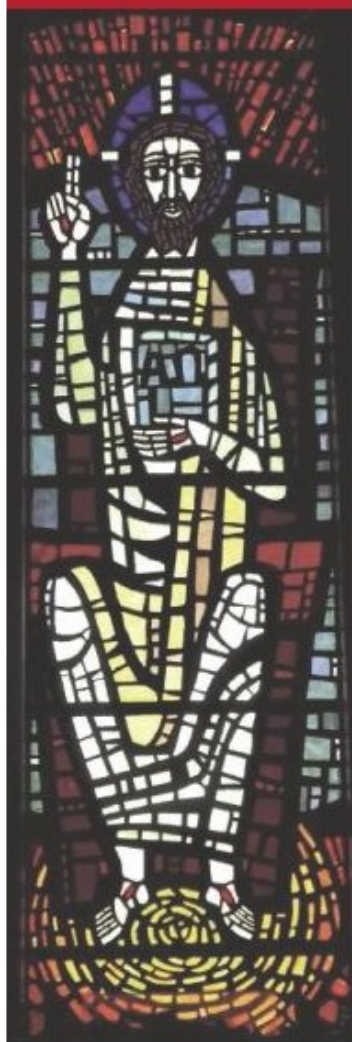

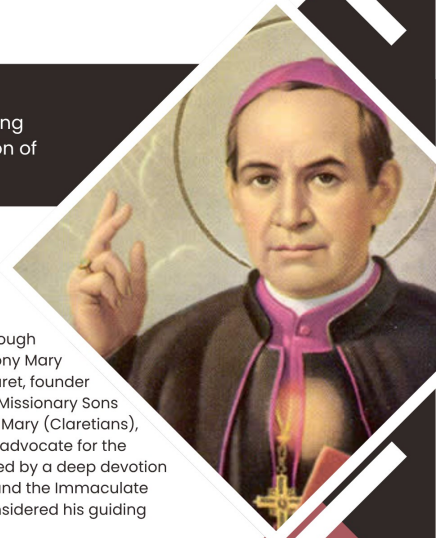

DID YOU KNOW?



Continuing our series about the seven themes in the doctrine of **Catholic Social Teaching** about building a holy, just society, we look at the sixth theme, “**solidarity**”:

“We are **one human family** whatever our national, racial, ethnic, economic, and ideological differences. We are **our brothers’ and sisters’ keepers**, wherever they may be. Loving our neighbor has **global dimensions** in a shrinking world. At the core of the virtue of solidarity is the pursuit of justice and peace. Pope [St.] Paul VI taught that ‘**if you want peace, work for justice.**’ The **Gospel** calls us to be peacemakers. Our love for all our sisters and brothers demands that we **promote peace** in a world surrounded by violence and conflict. ...

‘To love someone is to **desire** that person’s good and to **take effective steps** to secure it. Besides the good of the individual, there is the good that is linked to living in society: the common good. It is the good of “all of us”, made up of **individuals, families and intermediate groups** who together constitute society. ... To desire the **common good** and strive towards it is a **requirement** of justice and charity.’ (Pope Benedict XVI, Charity in Truth [Caritas in Veritate], no. 7) ” —United States Conference of Catholic Bishops’ “Solidarity” (emphasis added)

CEAC—BE THE LIGHT

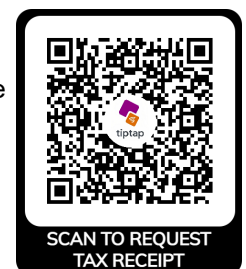

As you may recall, whenever you see our bright yellow sunshine posters in the church foyer, it means that we are collecting goods for a wonderful and worthy local cause, and we need your help! Please join Newman Center’s Community Engagement and Action Committee (CEAC) during the full month of September as we collect specific food items and essentials that will benefit our beloved MEMI Sisters, who work tirelessly to serve our local farm-working families in nearby farming communities. The MEMI Sisters assist families, primarily, by providing religious education for the campesino families, both children and parents. In addition to helping them prepare for their Catholic sacraments and learn their prayers, they also exemplify God’s bountiful love by caring for the basic daily needs of these families. This essential—but threatened—sector of our community, our campesinos, our farm workers, work the land every season to put food on our tables, but are often left with few provisions of their own. We know that Jesus told us, “Whatever you did for the least of my brothers and sisters, you did for me.” Let us “Be the Light” to help our MEMI Sisters serve these brothers and sisters in need! All you need to do is to remove one or more of the “sunrays” from the sunshine posters and return the requested item(s) to the receiving bins; gift certificates may be turned in at the reception desk. This event will run from September 1-30, 2026.

IGNATIUS SPIRITUALITY & TWELVE STEP RETREAT

This 12-week retreat led by John Prandini, MA, weaves together two spiritual traditions: the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises, born from the experience of a wounded soldier, Ignatius of Loyola, who encountered the living God in a season of enforced stillness; and the 12 Steps, born from the experience of broken and desperate people who discovered that surrender was not defeat, but liberation. These two rivers share the same source: the radical conviction that we cannot heal ourselves, that transformation comes as a gift, and that God's desire for our wholeness is deeper and more persistent than our own. Together they offer a path that is honest enough to face our wounds, gentle enough to hold our shame, and strong enough to carry us toward a freedom we may not yet be able to imagine. This retreat gently guides you through awareness, scripture, prayer, reflection, and practice from where you are now toward healing, wholeness, and the fullness of life that God intends for you.

We will meet weekly on Wednesdays, Aug. 26 – Nov. 18, 11:30 am-1:00 pm in the Library. Materials will be available for \$40; scholarships are available. To register, use the Flocknote link.
