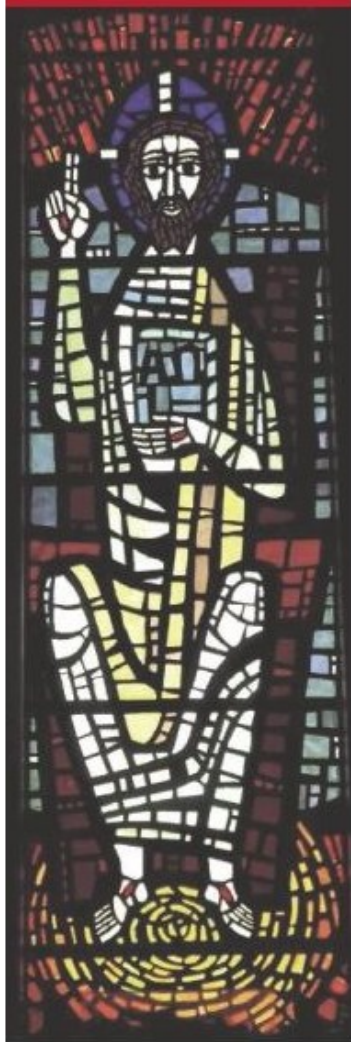

DID YOU KNOW?



As we honor grandparents today, we undertake Pope Leo XIV's call to the elderly to recognize themselves as **children of a loving Father**, and to all to visit them, so that none feel like a forgotten burden.

"Through the prophet Isaiah, the Lord promises that he will **never forget** any of us. He assures us that he has engraved our faces on the palms of his hands (cf. Is 49:16) and that **his love is greater than a**

mother's love for her child (cf. Is 49:15). ... [I]n homes where **loneliness** reigns and also in those care facilities where each person's uniqueness risks being reduced to a **bed number or an illness**, [the elderly are unrecognized and forgotten]. ... May this day, therefore, be an inspiration for everyone, especially the young, to revive the beautiful custom of **visiting** their grandparents, the elderly members of the family and even those who have no one to visit them. Bring them, through this message and your presence, the closeness and affection of the Pope. Ensure that the words of the prophet, 'But I will never forget you,' take the form of a **tender and affectionate encounter**."

A THANK YOU TO DEACON JOHN SUPINO

As we celebrate Founders Day and honor our first pastor, Fr. Sergio Negro, we would be remiss if we did not also mention Deacon John Supino.

Deak's service and dedication to the St. Paul Catholic Newman Center dates back to the very beginning. When the Newman Center first opened in 1964, the first Newman Club President was none other than John Supino. As an active student at Fresno State John helped set the stage for the wonderful university parish that we are today. After graduation, he continued as an active parishioner and in 2003 was ordained as our first deacon at the Newman Center. Shortly thereafter, Deak became the first lay administrator serving within the Diocese. In 2022, Deacon John retired from the Parish Life Coordinator role but remained an active deacon. In 2028 Deacon John will celebrate his 25th diaconate ordination anniversary.

Over the next couple of years as we look forward to a 25th anniversary celebration, Deak will be adjusting his liturgical schedule. He will continue to assist with Sunday preaching, though less frequently than in the past, and will assist with weddings and funerals. He will continue with Communion Services and serving on the Liturgy Committee and Pastoral Council. He will also continue to support and collaborate with the various Newman ministries and may explore new opportunities for service.

Please join us in thanking Deacon John for his decades of service and help us prepare for an amazing 25th anniversary celebration in 2028.

HEALING MASS

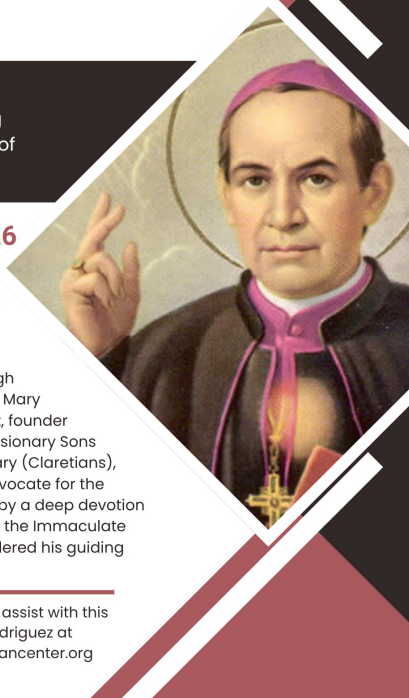

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GRIEF EDUCATION AND SUPPORT GROUP

Has someone close to you died and you are having difficulty with grieving? Then the St. Benedict Catholic Worker's Grief Education and Support Group may be for you. The Grief Education and Support Group is a 12-week experience facilitated by Liza Apper, Obl. OSB, MPS, Certified Grief Counselor.

Liza holds a B.A. in Theology from Creighton University and a M.A. in Pastoral Care & Counseling. Liza also has over 35 graduate credits with Dr. Alan Wolfelt (a leading grief therapist) that led to her certification as a grief counselor.

This group will help give you the tools to get through your grief and the support of others traveling on this grief journey. The Grief Education and Support Group will meet on Wednesday evenings from 7 to 9 p.m. starting Wednesday, September 23 and ending with graduation on Monday, December 14.

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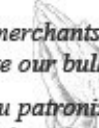
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
