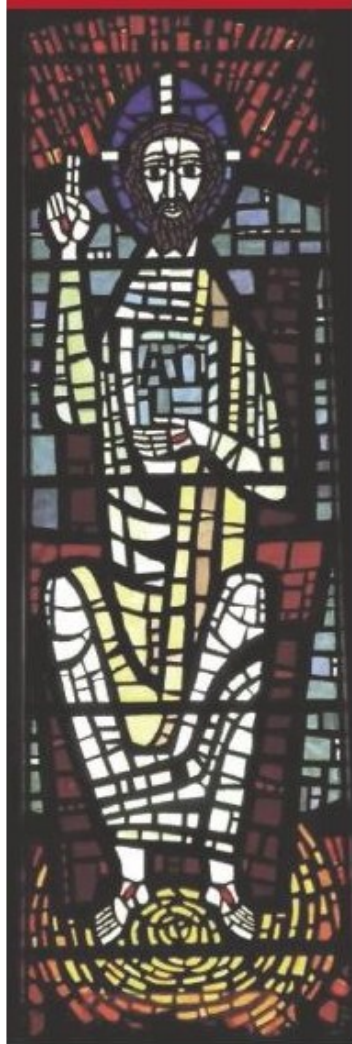

DID YOU KNOW?



Every month, the Pope invites us to pray with him for a particular intention; this September, we join him to pray for **“a just and sustainable management of water**, a vital resource, so that everyone may have equal access to it.” (<https://popesprayerusa.net/>)

The bishops of the United States also ask us to join in the Church's Season of Creation by:

- “[a]dopting sustainable behaviors within the family... to address current environmental challenges and promote the integral development of each person.”
- remembering our “dependence on God for life” by **praying “[b]efore and after meals...** a short prayer of thanksgiving for the lifegiving food that sustains and nourishes us. Briefly consider how all nourishment ultimately comes from the earth, and give thanks for all the human hands that helped bring this food to your table.”
- **Eucharistic Adoration and Confession:** “[C]elebrate [the] sacred reality... [a]s Laudato Si proclaims, through the Eucharist, ‘the whole cosmos gives thanks to God’ (no. 236)”. Confess “(e)very violation of **solidarity and civic friendship** (that) harms the environment’ (Caritas in Veritate, no. 51)]” and “perform... an act of **grateful contemplation** of God’s world’ (Laudato Si, no. 214)”. —USCCB’s 2026 Season of Creation bulletin insert (emphasis added)

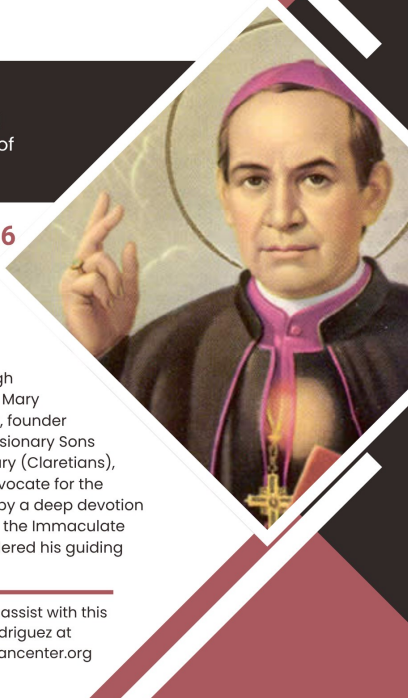

GRIEF EDUCATION AND SUPPORT GROUP

Has someone close to you died and you are having difficulty with grieving? Then the St. Benedict Catholic Worker's Grief Education and Support Group may be for you. The Grief Education and Support Group is a 12-week experience facilitated by Liza Apper, Obl. OSB, MPS, Certified Grief Counselor.

Liza holds a B.A. in Theology from Creighton University and a M.A. in Pastoral Care & Counseling. Liza also has over 35 graduate credits with Dr. Alan Wolfelt (a leading grief therapist) that led to her certification as a grief counselor.

This group will help give you the tools to get through your grief and the support of others traveling on this grief journey. The Grief Education and Support Group will meet on Wednesday evenings from 7 to 9 p.m. starting Wednesday, September 23 and ending with graduation on Monday, December 14.

The group will meet at The St. Benedict Catholic Worker House at 4022 N. Cheryl Ave. in Fresno (near Ashlan and Marks). The group is limited to 10 participants. For more information contact: Liza Apper at 977-3648.
